	<b>Instructions</b>
	<p>Congratulations Grub Masters, you have one of the most important jobs for your patrol. You determine how well your patrol eats! Do you job well and you and the other scouts will have a great campout, not so well . . .</p> <p>As the Grub Master you were given the Dry Box and the Cooler. What you need to do is make sure you have you essential items in you dry box and then add your food for the campout. Food that needs refrigerated goes in the cooler, stuff that won't spoil in the Dry Box.</p> <p>Before you leave make sure you have the items listed below. When you get back make sure your replenish anything you are low on and wash your rags.</p>
	<b>Dry Box</b>
	Small detergent, Small Bleach, 4 scouring pads, 2 small towels and 2 wash rags.
	5 large trash bags (13 gallon or larger)
	10 assorted zip lock bags
	Small plastic bottle of cooking oil.
	Sm sugar, sm flour, spices (salt / pepper)
	1 extra mess kit
	1 box stick matches
	2 rolls of paper towel (get the individually wrapped kind so it stays clean and dry)
	1 roll of toilet paper in a plastic bag (in case the camp runs out)
	A few cans of spare food (cans of chili, stew etc). This is in case something happens to one of your meals. Water only pancake mix stored in peanut butter jars can also work (if you leave it in the original box it can turn into a big mess)
	Some hot chocolate mix (can be a life saver when you are cold)
